WHY DID JESUS FOLD THE NAPKIN?

Why did Jesus fold the linen burial cloth after His resurrection?
I never noticed this...

The Gospel of John (20:7) tells us that the napkin, which was placed over the face of Jesus, was not just thrown aside like the grave clothes.

The Bible takes an entire verse to tell us that the napkin was neatly folded, and was placed at the head of that stony coffin.

Early Sunday morning, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance.

She ran and found Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one whom Jesus loved. She said, "They have taken the Lord's body out of the tomb, and I don't know where they have put Him!"

Peter and the other disciple ran to the tomb to see. The other disciple out ran Peter and got there first. He stopped and looked in and saw the linen cloth lying there, but he didn't go in.

Then Simon Peter arrived and went inside. He also noticed the linen wrappings lying there, while the cloth that had covered Jesus' head was folded up and lying to the side.

Was that important? Absolutely! Is it really significant? Yes!

In order to understand the significance of the folded napkin, you have to understand a little bit about Hebrew tradition of that day. The folded napkin had to do with the Master and Servant, and every Jewish boy knew this tradition.

When the servant set the dinner table for the master, he made sure that it was exactly the way the master wanted it.

The table was furnished perfectly, and then the servant would wait, just out of sight, until the master had finished eating, and the servant would not dare touch that table, until the master was finished..

Now if the master were done eating, he would rise from the table, wipe his fingers, his mouth, and clean his beard, and would wad up that napkin and toss it onto the table.

The servant would then know to clear the table. For in those days, the wadded napkin meant, "I'm finished.."

But if the master got up from the table, and folded his napkin, and laid it beside his plate, the servant would not dare touch the table, because the folded napkin meant, "I'M COMING BACK!"

New Things

Wow, we are almost finished going through the book of 1 Corinthians! Two more messages from the 16th chapter in April to bring us to a total of 36. We spent over six months with Paul and the Corinthian church. I am sure we learned from their mistakes so we can avoid making the same ones. I trust the Lord that Charis in Chaos, grace in the brokenness of the church, has helped us become a better church. I pray that we can look at our failures and have faith that through the grace of Christ we will be able to turn those failures into stepping stones to victory.

So what is next? First is a series called The Path of the Cross. Jesus said "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me." That doesn't sound very fun, does it? We are going to explore what it takes to actually take up our cross by looking at Jesus' life and how he bore His cross in life as well as death.

We will study the path of truth and the path of humility in April with more to follow in May.

Following the The Path series, we will begin one called The God of Angel Armies. The idea for this came from a recent Chris Tomlin song entitled 'Whom Shall I Fear.' We will spend a few weeks looking at the power of the God we serve, how He empowers us and why we don't have to fear when we are in Christ.

The third series will be Unprecedented. Our God is a God that does new things, unprecedented things, things never seen and done before. Has He changed in the last 2000 years? Absolutely not! God is still doing new and unprecedented things. We will look in the scriptures at some amazing things God has done throughout history and take encouragement that when it comes to our situations, we can have faith that God is still an unprecedented God waiting to do new things in our lives.

We are almost ready to begin a new study for the adult Sunday morning (9 am) study. We will continue with a different

Like we did with the last study, we will stretch this out over many more weeks in order to receive the full impact of what God wants to show us.

CORN CASSEROLE

½ c. margarine or butter
1 can whole kernel corn, drained
