

Growing Pains

The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. **Matthew 9:37**

Some of us might remember having growing pains when we were young. Some children have pains in their thighs, calves or behind their knees that seem to just be part of growing up. In the morning, the child seems to be just fine, but the pain usually occurs in the afternoon or evening. Some children are even awakened by them in the middle of the night.

A booming business might be said to have growing pains when the demand for products or services exceed the capacity to provide them and they scramble to find a way to satisfy the market.

A new nation has growing pains as constitutions and charters are challenged, as the kinks are worked out of the justice system and revenue and expenditures are trying to be balanced.

What about a church? When a church grows, new needs arise. Sometimes the problems are space, other times it is staffing. When these needs arise, people and money are required to meet those needs.

There is an old saying about those who work in the church. It says 20% of the people do 80% of the work. Maybe that is true, maybe it isn't. But what happens when there is more to be done? What do we do when another job pops up? Someone has to stand in the gap and do what needs to be done.

I know that God has not called us to be pew sitters. Church isn't a building. It isn't a couple of hours we set aside for worship and Bible study on Sunday morning. Church is community. Church is all the people working together to meet each other's needs and to grow the kingdom of God. Church is the Body of Christ.

Each one of us should look for ways to serve and be involved. We should encourage each other to be involved in areas where we have spiritual gifts, talents and passion.

God has blessed this church. Our church body has grown in attendance by about 30% in the last two years. That is a big praise! However, it also means there is more to be done and we need people to step up and do the work Christ has called us to do.

Look at three Old Testament prophets. Which response is closest to your response?

Moses: Moses witnessed the burning bush and God called him to confront Pharaoh and demand of, 'Let my people go!"

But Moses said to the LORD, "Oh, my Lord, I am not eloquent, either in the past or since you have spoken to your servant, but I am slow of speech and of tongue." Then the LORD said to him, "Who has made man's mouth? Who makes him mute, or deaf, or seeing, or blind? Is it not I, the LORD? Now therefore go, and I will be with your mouth and teach you what you shall speak." But he said, "Oh, my Lord, please send someone else."

Exodus 4:10-13

What happened when Moses gave that response? **Exodus 4:14** says, "*the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses.*"

We know that Moses was 'persuaded' by God to do what He commanded. But we don't have a burning bush. We don't see fire, smoke and lightening on the mountain. We normally don't audibly hear the voice of God express His displeasure with us. That would be scary (and maybe, like Moses, it would make us more 'eager' to serve)!

When a need arises, do you say, 'Lord, please send someone else?'

Jeremiah: Jeremiah didn't say send someone else, but he had reservations.

Now the word of the LORD came to me, saying, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations." Then I said, "Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, I do not know how to speak, for I am only a youth." But the LORD said to me, "Do not say, 'I am only a youth'; for to all to whom I send you, you shall go, and whatever I command you, you shall speak. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, declares the LORD." Then the LORD put out his hand and touched my mouth. And the LORD said to me, "Behold, I have put my words in your mouth. See, I have set you this day over nations and over kingdoms, to pluck up and to break down, to destroy and to overthrow, to build and to plant." **Jeremiah 1:4-10**

Jeremiah just didn't know how he could do what God asked. God made it clear. "I made you; I know you. I will be with you I will equip you to do what I have called you to do."

When the need arises, do you say, 'I'd like to help, but I just don't know how I could do that?' When you are unsure or insecure, God will equip you too!

Recipe Swap

ANGEL FOOD ICE CREAM CAKE

1 angel food cake
½ gallon vanilla ice cream, slightly softened
2 quarts fresh strawberries
Sugar to taste

Cut the cake in half; tear one half into small pieces and set aside. Cut the other half into 12-14 thin slices; arrange in the bottom of a waxed paper lined 13x9x2 inch baking pan, overlapping as needed. Spread softened ice cream over cake, pressing down to smooth. Gently press the small cake pieces into ice cream. Cover and freeze. Just before serving, slice strawberries and sweeten to taste. Cut dessert into squares and top with strawberries. Yield: 15 servings.

Isaiah: And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" Then I said, "Here I am! Send me." Isaiah 6:8

Here is one immediate need we must fill. We have been blessed by having some very young children in the nursery during the Sunday school hour. This is too much for one person to handle – trying to teach 3-4 year olds while keeping the 2 year olds busy. We need someone to assist Gina in the nursery during Sunday school to help with the youngest children in there. You don't have to prepare a lesson, just comfort and play with the very young. If enough people step up, this could be done on a rotating basis so the volunteers would only be in there once every three or four weeks.

So what will it be? Will you say, "Lord, please send someone else!" Maybe your response is, "How could I do that, Lord?" My prayer is that it is, "Here I am Lord, send me!"

May God continue to bless this church with a great harvest and may He provide enough workers for the task He has called us to!
