The artist had captured the fury of the wind as it whipped black rain clouds which were laced with streaks of lightning. The sea was roaring in turmoil, waves churning, the dark sky filled with the power of the furious thunderstorm.

And in the middle of the picture, under a cliff, the artist had painted a small bird, safe and dry in her nest snuggled safely in the rocks. The bird was at peace midst the storm that raged about her.



The Word of the Month: Peace

*“Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I have not come to bring peace, but a sword. **Matthew 10:34***

What? Whoa, whoa! Did Jesus really say that? Surely he was misquoted by some overzealous first century journalist that had Pharisaical leanings!

Nope, sources say one of his close allies, a former tax collector named Matthew, confirms the story.

Won't this hurt Jesus' chances of being elected Messiah? He's running on a platform of being the Prince of Peace, and then tells us he didn't come to bring peace?

It is a good thing Jesus didn't 'run' for the office of Savior. He just is the Savior. Oh, he might have been elected at the beginning of his ministry, when he was healing and feeding people and casting out demons. The people wanted to make him king by force.

Then he started the hard teaching about the kingdom of God. The first will be last. The greatest in the kingdom must be a servant to all. How we must consume Jesus or we have no part in him. That he must suffer and die and be raised on the third day. And if they persecuted Jesus, the master, then those who follow must expect persecution as well.

Part of that persecution may even come from your own family or friends. Following Jesus can bring division with those who aren't believers or aren't serious about their faith.

Those campaign promises couldn't get you elected dog catcher, let alone the Savior of the world.

So where is the peace? Does Jesus bring peace or not?

The peace Jesus offers isn't the kind of peace the world is looking for. The world is looking to live in peace with each other, in the natural realm. That is a noble cause and should be sought after. However, our differing interpretations about what peace is (lack of war, everyone gets along, leave me alone and I will leave you alone, everyone shares everything) along with our sin nature makes it impossible.

Look at a few verses about Jesus and peace.

Isaiah 9:6 (ESV) *For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.*

When the angels announced the birth of Jesus to the shepherds, they said, “*Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!*”

Did you catch that? Not merely peace on earth. Peace among those who please God!

The peace Jesus offers is peace with God. We can't achieve that peace on our own. We MUST have Jesus!

In our sinfulness, no one is at peace with God. **Colossians 1:21 (NIV)** *Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior.*

We were enemies with God. We didn't have peace with God; we were at war with God because of our sin!

Jesus didn't bring peace by coming to the earth and defeating every enemy of God. He brought us peace with God by his very life and death. **Isaiah 53:5** *But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us **peace**, and with his wounds we are healed.*

Jesus lived the perfect life that we could never live. He became the perfect sacrifice to pay the debt of our sin. Fully God and fully man taking upon himself the punishment for the sins of all mankind so that those who receive him as Lord and Savior will have peace with God.

This peace we receive from God is to rule our hearts (Col 3:15). It transcends anything we can understand (Phil 4:7). It is not a worldly peace.

John 14:27 *Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.*

This world is full of danger. People are afraid. Politicians may pledge to keep us safe or bring us peace, but they can't promise true and lasting peace. Only Jesus can do that.

Recipe Swap TURTLE COOKIES

2 cups, minus 2 T. cake flour (reg)
1 2/3 cups bread flour
1 1/4 tsp. baking soda
1 1/2 tsp. baking powder
1 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
2 1/2 sticks butter
1 1/4 cups brown sugar
1 cup, plus 2 T. sugar
2 large eggs
2 tsp. vanilla
2 cups dark chocolate chips
1 cup caramel bits
1 cup chopped pecans

Mix all together and chill 36 hours. Make into golf ball sized balls, bake at 350* for 18-20 minutes. You can make them a little smaller, just bake them for about 12 minutes.
