Youth: noun, often attributive \ 'yüth\

1 *a: the time of life when one is young; especially, the period between childhood and maturity. b: the early period of existence, growth, or development*

2 *a: a young person; especially between adolescence and maturity. b: young persons or creatures —usually plural in construction*

Proverbs 22:6 says, “Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it.” This is a principle, not a promise. It is a general rule that applies to Christian parents. If you will train your children in the ways of the Lord Jesus Christ, even if there is a prodigal season, your child will likely return to those roots of faith.

This, unfortunately, will not happen 100% of the time. Each child has their own individual will, as well as a sin nature common to all people. They must personally choose to follow Christ and remain in the faith.

A parent’s job is to prepare the soil of the heart so that when the seed of faith is sown, it will grow strong in your child and reap a harvest of righteousness. I said a few weeks ago, a child’s character is not the responsibility of the school, the youth minister, the church, or anyone else except the parents. God has given parents that right, that privilege and that responsibility.

The church’s job is to come alongside the parent and encourage them, reinforce Bible teaching and help mold the young person to choose to follow Christ.

We want our young people to demonstrate these scripture selections now and in the future.

Psalm 71:5 (ESV) *For you, O Lord, are my hope, my trust, O LORD, from my youth.*

Psalm 71:17 (ESV) *O God, from my youth you have taught me, and I still proclaim your wondrous deeds.*

1 Timothy 4:12 (ESV) *Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.*

2 Timothy 2:22 (ESV) *So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart.*

When we come together for youth group on Sunday evenings, we are trying to instill biblical values in the young people. Not every youth that attends has Christian parents. For them, we are trying to give basic instruction and lead them to Christ. For the youth whose parents are Christians, we want to reinforce the biblical teaching they should be receiving at home.

We want to encourage the youth and let them know they have purpose and value. They have a place in the body of Christ. We want them to know that being a Christian is fulfilling, joyful and fun. We also want them to know that the decisions they make now may impact them long into the future, so we try to teach them to make good and godly decisions that are Bible based. We want them to know that sin is real and there is absolute right and wrong in the world.

So here is a typical youth group session. We worship. We will sing two or three songs together along with a video. Music is so impactful for all people. We can remember song lyrics more easily than scripture (this is no excuse to NOT read your Bible or memorize scripture).

Recipe Swap

CHOCOLATE PEANUT DELIGHT

1 pkg. chocolate cake mix
½ c. butter, melted
¼ c. milk
1 egg
1 cup chopped peanuts, divided
8 oz. softened cream cheese
1 c. peanut butter
1 c. powdered sugar
14 oz. sweetened condensed milk
1-1/2 tsp. vanilla
16 oz. cool whip, divided
½ c. semisweet chocolate chips
4-1/2 tsp. butter
½ tsp. vanilla

In a bowl, combine dry cake mix, melted butter, milk and egg. Add ¾ c. of the peanuts. Spread into a greased 13x9 pan. Bake at 350* for 30 minutes or till done. Cool on a wire rack. In a mixing bowl, beat the cream cheese, peanut butter, powdered sugar, condensed milk and vanilla until smooth. Fold in 3 cups cool whip. Spread over the cake; top with the remaining cool whip and peanuts. In the microwave in a bowl heat chocolate chips and butter on high for 1 minute or until melted. Stir in vanilla until smooth. Drizzle over cake. Refrigerate for 2-3 hours.
