RECIPE SWAP

SKILLET APPLE PIE BISCUITS

8 frozen buttermilk biscuits, thawed 21 oz. can apple pie filling ¹/₂ c. butter, melted ¹/₂ c. light brown sugar 1 T. cinnamon 1 tsp. vanilla ¹/8 tsp. nutmeg ¹/4 c. walnut or pecan pieces (optional) Glaze: (double if desired) ¹/₂ c. powdered sugar 2-3 T. cream, half and half, or milk

Preheat oven to 375*. Melt the butter and brush on all sides of the cast iron skillet. If you don't have one you can use any comparable baking dish. In a bowl, mix brown sugar, cinnamon and nutmeg. Dip each biscuit in the butter and sprinkle on all sides with the cinnamon sugar mixture. Arrange side by side in the skillet. Cut the apples in the pie filling into smaller pieces, and mix in 1 tsp. of vanilla. Arrange over the biscuits. Pour the remaining butter over all and sprinkle the remaining cinnamon sugar on top. Bake for 30-35 minutes, until golden and puffy. Mix the glaze and drizzle on top. Serve hot.
