Read your Bible!

There are numerous Bible reading plans that help you to read the entire Bible in a year. I will make a couple of those plans available before January. There are also numerous other plans to be found online.

However, I won't recommend a plan if it is simply a to-do checklist to try to please God, but not read for comprehension and life change. I won't recommend a plan if it becomes a burden and actually discourages you from digging into God's word.

I would rather have you read one chapter a day and get something out of it than have the scriptures become a burdensome chore or a work to prove your devotion to God or man.

Even if it is a few paragraphs, or a few verses, do your best to be in the word every day. Soak in the word of God. Meditate on it. Try to memorize a few verses. Read a daily devotional.

Why is God's word so important? It is divine instruction. 2 Tim. 3:16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

It gives direction. *Psalm 119:105 Your* word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

It tells of salvation. John 5:24 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.

When Jesus asked if Peter wanted to leave, Peter responded, John 6:68 "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." Peter continued, "We have believed and come to know you are the Holy One of God."

In January, I will preach through the book of Ruth. If you read that beforehand (it is only four chapters), you will better follow the teaching on Sunday morning.

After Ruth, we will go through Mark. Later on in 2023, we will study passages in Isaiah that point to Christ.

Until then, here is last year's December scripture list get us in the mindset for Christmas, as we celebrate the presence of Christ coming in human form to bring salvation to all who choose to follow him in faith.
