February is the month of love. If you try to find the history of Valentine's Day, you will find it is murky at best. There are three different Saint Valentines that people want to claim the day is named after. There is also a pagan Roman festival that others want declare is the source of the holiday.

Biblical love is, by far, deeper and richer than the romantic love celebrated at Valentine's Day. The ancient Greeks have several different words for love to express that depth.

Eros is romantic love. Storge is family love. While these words are from the ancient Greek that the New Testament was written in, neither appear in the Bible.

The Bible has Philia and Agape. Philia is brotherly love or friendship love between two people. That is why <u>Phila</u>delphia is named "The City of Brotherly Love."

Agape is unconditional love. God's love for us is agape love. It is 'John 3:16 love.' God calls on us to love (agape) Him as well as our neighbors.

Now I love bluegrass music. (That love is none of the above types!) The genre does a pretty good job of producing some Bible-themed songs. I'd like to share the lyrics of a song written by bluegrass artist Rhonda Vincent. It sounds like the right kind of love for February.
