'Logos' is ancient Greek for 'word.' John 1:1 In the beginning was the Logos [Word]... Verse 14 completes the thought with, "and the Logos [Word] became flesh and made his dwelling with man." Jesus is the Word incarnate!

John Lennox stated, "In biology, we have at the heart of every living cell, the longest word ever found, the genetic code. All of that leads me to formulate it as follows: we live in a wordbased universe. That is the key of the Logos for me."

He continued, "It means that this universe is not simply a product of natural unguided forces. It is a product of a rational creator, an intelligent creator, and I believe even more than that a personal creator."
