Webster's Dictionary defines **soteriology** as the "theology dealing with salvation especially as effected by Jesus Christ." **Soter** is Greek for savior. **Soterion** is Greek for salvation.

There are lengthy books and entire seminary classes teaching us about soteriology.

There are also secular forms of soteriology. Secular "salvation" won't mean the same thing as Christian salvation. First, if there is no belief in heaven or hell, salvation could only be understood as having had a meaningful life. That might be achieved by doing good works or saying and thinking according to worldly philosophies.

Other (false) religions may deem salvation as becoming one with mother nature or the universe, or even having your own new world to populate and be god over. None of these secular or pagan methods can save you for eternity.

You don't need fancy words to know how to be saved. You don't need a college class to understand how it works. You need someone to share the gospel (and a Bible would be helpful).

You need to know that the God of the Bible is real. He is perfect and holy and we all sin and fall short of his perfect righteousness and deserve death. That means we need saving.

You need to know Jesus. You need to know he is God the Son, who took on flesh and was born of a virgin. He lived the perfect life we couldn't and his death on the cross paid the price for the death we deserve for sin.

You need to know that his resurrection is the proof that God the Father accepted his sacrifice on our behalf, and that he defeated sin and death to guarantee eternal life for those who receive him by faith.

You need to know salvation is only through Jesus Christ. Acts 4:12 And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

Easter is the celebration of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who died for us. The scriptures this month speak to us of salvation and take us through Holy Week. So dig in and know the salvation of the Lord. If you aren't a Christian, please receive Christ as your Lord and Savior!
