After preaching a sermon encouraging everyone we should pray while we wait for the return of Christ, I was painfully aware of how much the Bible teaches on prayer that I was not able to include in the message.

There is enough about prayer in the scriptures for an entire series addressing our questions about it. Why do prayers seem to not be answered? Why do I sometimes feel like I'm just talking to the sky and that's it? Why do I need to pray if God already knows what I need? How do I know for sure I have an answer? How do I know I'm praying correctly? Am I being selfish? Does prayer really do anything? The questions can go on and on.

When I feel like I'm not praying like I ought to, I take comfort in the fact that God is so full of love, grace and mercy.

When our toddlers don't quite articulate their thoughts to us, mix up words, misunderstand what we say to them, or can't put it into words at all, we continue to love them. We also try to draw out what they are really trying to communicate. We want to understand the hearts of our children.

We are that two-year-old in God's eyes. While God already knows our hearts, he wants us to open ourselves to him. He longs for us to cry out to him and seek his face. He is not nearly as concerned that we use the proper words or get things in the right order as he is that we desire to connect with him heart to heart.

Whether it is in the Psalms, the parables of Jesus, Old Testament examples or New Testament epistles, we see that prayer is essential to our relationship with the Lord. We can learn so much by simply reading what the Bible says concerning prayer.

Read, meditate on, and pray over the following verses. If you have extra time, read the context and look up related references. Be blessed! Before beginning, go ahead and read Romans 12:12, Colossians 4:2, 1 Thessalonians 5:17, 1 Timothy 2:1.
