We will finish Revelation in September. What next? Revelation has been intense. It has been both heavy and exceedingly joyous. How does one follow that up?

Remember way back in chapter 1. Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near. **Revelation 1:3**

How do we receive that blessing? Look at this verse from chapter 22. "And behold, I am coming soon. Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."

Revelation 22:7

So we are blessed in the hearing and we are blessed in the keeping.

Peter asks concerning the return of Christ, "...what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness, waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God... 2 Peter 3:11-12

The next series is "While We Wait." It is a series that will teach us what kind of people to be. Knowing that Christ will return and there will be a judgment, we'll learn how we should conduct our lives. This is how we can keep the words.

You've been provided with a scripture selection for each day to keep the return of Christ fresh in your mind. These verses are in the order they are found in the Bible; not necessarily in chronological order of the end times.

Some of these verses confirm that Jesus will return bodily. Some that there will be judgment and rewards. Some remind us we don't know the time of his return. Some describe Christ's return, others the millennial kingdom, yet others the eternal dwelling of God and man.
