The entire Bible is important. The Christian Churches and Churches of Christ are part of the Restoration Movement – the goal being to establish first century church principles that have been lost through the ages. I like to say we want to be the best first century church we can, in the 21st century.

Because of that, Christian Churches are typically known as 'New Testament' churches. That doesn't mean we should, in the misguided words of Andy Stanley, "unhitch ourselves from the Old Testament."

The Old Testament tells us about the character of God. It teaches us origins. The origin of the universe. The origin of sin. The origin of nations and languages. The origin of God's chosen people.

It shows a God who loves and longs to bring people out of slavery. Most importantly, it points to Jesus Christ, the solution for our slavery to sin and our separation from our creator. Without an understanding of the Old Testament, we can never fully understand or appreciate the New Testament.

While the Old Testament points to Jesus, the gospels ARE Jesus. They are his life, teachings and miracles. They show his love and compassion. They share Jesus' atoning death, burial and resurrection through which mankind is saved.

Acts is the beginning of the church of Jesus, the body of Christ. The epistles tells us how to believe and live in light of what Jesus has done for us. They point back to the cross. Yet, they also point forward to Revelation – the return of Christ.

Jesus is the center of all the scriptures, so all scripture is important, even the 'boring' parts. If it was important enough for God to give it to us, we can't ignore it. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in right-eousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Over the next couple of months, I will share a verse from each book of the Bible (not necessarily the most important verse). You might be able to memorize it. You will want to read the verse in context. Read at least five verses before and five after to understand what the verse means.

Romans 15:4 For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.
