Rejoice always. (1 Thessalonians 5:16)

"Choose joy!"

"Don't let anyone steal your joy!"

These and similar commands give us the idea that joy is a mindset. "This is a horrible day. I just have to choose to be joyful anyway!"

"Ugh, here comes (fill in name). They are always so negative and hateful. I'm not going to let them steal my joy."

That sounds good on the surface, but is perhaps not easy to do in reality.

Many verses in the Proverbs speak of joy. Some of these passages make joy seem to depend upon circumstances. True justice carried out brings joy. Obedient children, good news, and the increase of righteousness in the land should make us joyful. Can we be joyful even if our children wander, and if we live in an unjust, wicked land?

Even in the worst circumstances, we can find something that anchors us in joy. That 'something' must be transcendent. Not able to be altered by worldly events. It must be good, righteous and true so that it can elicit feelings of gladness.

It must be powerful enough to overcome the darkness and evil that seek to destroy our joy. There is one who can bring that joy no matter what your situation is. Jesus is our constant source of joy!

In the Old Testament, joy is repeatedly shown to be the natural outcome of fellowship with God. We are told to leap for joy and shout for joy, all in the midst of our praise to God because of the blessings God has given us.

The New Testament shows us joy ultimately manifests itself in Christ. Only through the Son can we have true fellowship with the Father. Only in our relationship with Jesus can we have forgiveness of sins and the hope of heaven.

The centuries the Jewish people spent anticipating the Messiah were fulfilled when 'the child was born and the son was given.' This is not just for the Jewish people, but for all who receive Jesus as their Savior. Luke 2:10-11 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. To-

day in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord."

Best of all, when we are in Christ, enjoying his fellowship, and God's will is done, God is joyful. I pray a joyful Christmas for all!
