Mild he lays his glory by, Born that man no more may die, Born to raise the sons of earth. Born to give us second birth. Hark! the herald angels sing,

"Glory to the new born King!"

Finally, from the modern Christmas song Born in Bethlehem: Baby Jesus, do You know you'll die for all our sins? Don't be afraid for in three days You will rise again! Hallelujah, the King is here given for all men, for today the holy son of God is born in Bethlehem.

He is risen because he was crucified. How can we not be thankful? Merry Christmas! May God bless you as you read about the prophecies and birth of our Lord Jesus Christ this month.


