"I'm sorry for _____. Will you forgive me?" That was the formula we tried to use when one child did something against the other. The proper response was, "Yes, I forgive you." It was not always easy, but we were doing the best we could to teach them the biblical concept of forgiveness.

We must be willing to forgive because God in Christ forgives us. In fact, Jesus taught in the Sermon on the Mount, that if we won't forgive others for their offenses against us, God won't forgive our offenses against him (Matthew 6:15).

So now I am going to ask you to forgive me! "I'm sorry for <u>using AI to write this article</u>. Will you forgive me? I asked the AI (artificial intelligence) model, Grok, to summarize the biblical teaching on forgiveness. It gave a pretty long list of bullet points and cited several scriptures.

While I may not perfectly agree with everything in its answer, the summary was pretty good. Here it is: "Biblical forgiveness flows from God's gracious forgiveness of humanity through Christ. Believers are commanded to forgive others generously, reflecting God's mercy, to foster reconciliation, personal healing, and alignment with God's will. Forgiveness doesn't negate justice or always require reconciliation but frees the forgiver and honors God. Key verses like Matthew 6:14-15 and Ephesians 4:32 encapsulate this dual dynamic of receiving and extending forgiveness." (That little section in italics is the only part I used AI for!)

The danger of Al? There's a person(s) behind it somewhere. People are biased. But Al learns, which could be good or bad. One part of the answer that was wrong said forgiveness is "often tied to repentance and faith." I responded that it is <u>always</u> tied to repentance and faith in Jesus Christ. Grok changed its answer in agreement with me!

I want to assure you I do NOT use AI to write sermons. I wouldn't consider it ethical, for instance, to present to the church a sermon that was developed through AI as my own. While I see its usefulness in some areas of research, it is the responsibility of the preacher to prayerfully wrestle with God's word and "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15)

This month's verses will show what the Bible teaches on forgiveness. Please read the passages in context and pray a prayer of thanksgiving that God is forgiving, and a prayer that we will have a heart to forgive others.
