How much faith do you have in the weather forecast? I have some faith. At least they give us percentages. 50%, 2%, 90%, you know what I mean.

Do you have enough faith to get on a Boeing jet and fly across the United States? "Pay no attention to the parts falling off!" Do you have less faith in air travel than you did a few years ago?

Our religion is based upon faith. We call it 'the faith.' Paul said he was an apostle for the sake of 'the faith,' meaning Christianity.

Some people don't want to take a step of faith and believe in Jesus. They say they must be 100% sure before they could become a Christian. They claim to be based upon reason, but in reality, it is a silly stance.

You can never be 100% sure about anything. You go to the pharmacy to pick up your latest prescription. Do you take your chemistry set and analyze one of the pills on the counter to make sure it is the right medicine and right dosage? No, you have faith they got it right.

There are so many things in everyday life we put our faith in that we don't even think about it. Oh, things could go wrong, but they usually don't. The evidence tells us that.

Yet when it comes to Christianity, skeptics say something like, "How can you believe in your invisible Santa in the sky? You must be weak to have to put your faith in God."

Our faith in Christ is not a leap into the dark, but a step into the light. It is based upon evidence, but if we were100% sure, then it wouldn't be faith!

Why do so few people have faith in our government? Because they have witnessed the poor budgeting, poor management, poor enforcement of laws, and corruption. Evidence tells us it is not very deserving of our faith.

What is our evidence for faith? The risen Christ.! It is the witnesses that have written down the accounts of the life, death and resurrection of Christ. Since Christ promised to rise from the dead and kept that promise, I choose to believe every claim he makes.

Read about God's faithfulness, our faith, and 'the faith.' Look for words like believe and trust. If you have the faith of a mustard seed... well, look that one up in your Bible!




