I began preaching at VFCC in September of 2003. At the end of a three-month trial period, the church voted to call me as their full-time pastor. It has now been over twenty years since my December 2003 anniversary as the minister of our church.

The elders have graciously granted me a sabbatical. So from June 3 to July 3, I will be resting. I will be away from all the duties of pastoring for a month.

The word sabbatical has its origin in the word Sabbath. God created in six days and rested on the Sabbath. God didn't need to rest. He didn't run out of energy. He stopped from his work as an example for us to take time to stop from our work.

God ordained that even the land should be rested every seventh year.

Today, Christians are not under the law, but are under grace. Nine of the Ten Commandments are repeated in the New Testament. Remember the Sabbath day is the one commandment that is not explicitly repeated. Yet, the principle still remains that we need rest.

Not only is there a principle of rest, there is a promise of rest. Hebrews makes it clear that the Promised Land Joshua led the Hebrew children into was not the land of permanent rest. Our rest is Jesus Christ.

In Christ, we have the promise of eternal life. Life where there is no pain, or death, or sin or darkness. It is a life of peace. When we enter into glory, it will indeed be a time of true rest for our souls.

Until then, even though we aren't called to keep the Sabbath, we are called to rest. We can rest on the first day of the week, when we worship together. We aren't held to a specific time, but God knows us. He knows we would wear ourselves out. So he tells us to rest. Find a time of peace and rest. Even Jesus went away at times to rest.

The verses this month highlight God's Sabbath law. They teach us to rest from our work, our striving, from turmoil and stress. They will show us the blessings of rest as well as the discipline or consequences if we don't rest.

We cannot find true rest in the things of this world. Whether it is amassing riches to be seen by men or trying to amass righteousness to be accepted by God, we can't keep striving. It isn't physically, emotionally or spiritually healthy. That is why Jesus said, "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11:28).

I will miss you all in June, but I will be back in July, restored and ready to work for Christ together. Until then, read and meditate on these verses about rest and peace.
