Scripture memory. The eyes start to glaze over. The brain goes foggy. Why is memorizing scripture so hard?

Maybe something in us fights because it feels too much like homework. For others, it seems so 'works oriented.' We don't have to have thirty Bible verses memorized to get into heaven. Checking another box on a Christian to-do list can't add to our grace.

It is just really hard for some people. I know people who struggle with memorization. The thought of trying to commit a bunch of Bible verses to memory is intimidating, so they don't even want to begin.

Let me give you some reasons FOR memorizing scripture. David wrote that it helps us in our fight against sin (see May 1 verse).

It is a weapon in spiritual warfare. Ephesians 6 tells us the word of God is the sword of the Spirit.

We are told to think about what is pure and holy. Every thought is to be taken captive to Christ. We must set our minds on things that are above. What better way to make our hearts and minds conform to Christ than by keeping God's word hidden there?

There are stories of Christians in persecuted countries. After their Bibles were confiscated or they were imprisoned, the only way they had God's word is because they memorized it. The point being, wherever you are, you have it!

So, this month we are doing something different. I am sharing one passage every day with the challenge to try to commit it to memory.

WAIT! Don't shut me down. There's no pressure. There will not be a test! Some verses you probably already know. Some are very short. Even if you memorize a few, you have made progress! The verses are in no particular order in the list. Also, these aren't THE most important verses in the Bible. They are important, though.

Read the verse in context. Read at least five verses before and five after to get a feel of what the verse means. For instance, Romans 8:28 doesn't mean no bad things will happen. Philippians 4:13 doesn't mean you can do anything as long as you believe in Jesus.

Then you can read the memory verse to yourself a few more times. Maybe write it out a couple of times. I use the app Remember Me.

Young families, involve your kids. Make it part of family time. It only takes a few minutes. Remember, God's word is more valuable than gold and sweeter than honey (Psalm 19:10)!
