If you have been following along with the scripture lists, last month I selected one verse from each book of the Bible. Since there are sixty-six books, this list is split into two months.

Remember the Old Testament tells us about the character of God. It teaches us origins. The origin of the universe. The origin of sin. The origin of nations and languages. The origin of God's chosen people.

It shows a God who loves and longs to bring people out of slavery. Most importantly, it points to Jesus Christ, the solution for our slavery to sin and our separation from our creator. Without an understanding of the Old Testament, we can never fully understand or appreciate the New Testament.

This month we finish up the Old Testament verses and move into the New Testament. I will offer one verse from each book. The gospels give us the life of Christ. Acts gives us the life of the church. The epistles teach us doctrine and how to live a Christian life. Revelation brings this world to an end and gives us a glimpse of eternal life. The entire Bible is about the abundant life God offers to us through faith in Jesus Christ.

I could ask ten people the most important verse, or their favorite verse from a New Testament book and possibly get ten different answers. Especially if I ask about the longer gospels, doctrine rich Romans, or the very 'quotable' James or Philippians.

The verses I listed are not necessarily the ones I think are most important. Don't assume they are my favorites. I did pick verses that expressed great truths about God, Jesus, doctrine, and the Christian life. They should encourage you and take you deeper into the word. I also picked verses that might be easier to commit to memory. Since all scripture is useful [2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work. 1. it would be wise to store it up in our hearts so we can grow closer to our Lord.

You will want to read these verses in context. Read at least five verses before and five after to understand what the verse means.

As Paul reminded Timothy, 2 Timothy 3:15 ... from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.
